

BURLEIGH BARS STAINLESS STEEL HANDLE BAR WARRANTY

1. WHAT THIS WARRANTY COVERS:

Burleigh Bars offers you a warranty that the enclosed Product and its enclosed accessories will be free from defects in material and workmanship according to the following terms and conditions:

- (1) The warranty for the Product is for (7) years beginning on the date of purchase of the Product.
- (2) The warranty extends only to the original consumer purchaser of the Product ("Customer") and is not assignable or transferable to any subsequent customer.
- (3) This warranty is good only to the Customer during the warranty period as long as it is in AUSTRALIA.
- (4) During the warranty period, any defective Burleigh Bars Product or part will be repaired or replaced by Burleigh Bars or its authorised service centre, at Burleigh Bars option, with new or factory rebuilt replacement items. Burleigh Bars or the authorised service centre will return the Product to the Customer in working condition. No charge for either parts or labour in repair or replacement of the Product will be incurred by the Customer. If parts or equipment are replaced, they shall become the property of Burleigh Bars.
- (5) Upon request from Burleigh Bars, the Customer must provide Burleigh Bars with proof of the date of purchase.
- (6) The Customer will bear the cost of transporting, delivering and handling the Product to and from Burleigh Bars or its authorised service centre.
- (7) The benefits available from this warranty are in addition to all applicable statutory rights.

2. WHAT THIS WARRANTY DOES NOT COVER:

- (1) Warranty does NOT cover discoloration or shine.
- (2) Defects or damage resulting from use of the Product in other than its normal and customary manner.
- (3) Defects or damage from abnormal use, abnormal conditions, improper storage, exposure to moisture or dampness, unauthorised modifications, unauthorised connections, unauthorised repair, misuse, neglect, abuse, accident, alteration, improper installation, or other acts which are not the fault of Burleigh Bars, including damage caused by shipping, spills of food or liquid.
- (4) Breakage or damage, unless caused directly by defects in material or workmanship.
- (5) If the Customer does not notify Burleigh Bars of the alleged defect or malfunction of the Product during the applicable warranty period, the Customer shall have no coverage or benefits under this warranty.
- (6) Products which have had the serial number removed or made illegible.

THE FINE PRINT

Unfortunately, as is the case with any warranty policy, there are some exceptions and conditions:

A proof-of-purchase MUST accompany any warranty claim. The receipt must include the date of purchase, your name, your bike shop's name, and an itemized list of what was purchased. In the case that the bar was added as an upgrade to a new bike sale, the bar must be listed on the invoice. The warranty period begins on the purchase date of the original handle bar, as indicated by your proof-of-purchase. It ends on the same day, one year later.

For lay-away sales, the warranty begins on the day that you take the handlebar home. This is usually, but not always, the day of final payment. The 7 year period does not renew itself when a warranty replacement is issued. For example, if the handlebar were purchased on May 10th, 2002, the warranty would expire on May 10th, 2009. If, on February 15th, 2003 you receive a replacement handlebar, the warranty still expires on May 10th, 2009.

If you shorten the length of your bars by cutting them, and you decide you liked them better before they were cut, you do not qualify for a warranty replacement.

Shipping and handling costs are your responsibility.

Cosmetic damage is not covered by this policy.

This handlebar is intended for Motorcycle use only. Use on any other type of vehicle shall void the warranty.

Please note: installation and/or use of this handlebar on your bike indicates full acceptance of this policy in its entirety. This includes, and is not limited to, installations carried out by you the rider or by the service technicians at your bike shop.

The responsibility of Burleigh Bars under this warranty is limited to the value of the handlebar. It does not cover any damages or losses, both real and perceived, incurred through failure of the handlebar.

After the 7 year warranty period has ended, Burleigh Bars is released from all responsibilities, warranty related or otherwise, associated with the handle bar.

PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU PLACE YOUR WARRANTY STICKER FROM HANDLEBAR ON TO ORIGINAL INVOICE/RECEIPT.
